The Focus Power 36 is a stylish, high-performance motor yacht, built to cater for the mixed recreation of the modern powerboater. Designed by acclaimed naval architect, Tony Castro, she features a range of living and entertaining zones for the ultimate combination of feel-good summer sport and practical long-distance cruising.

With her raked hull windows, swept screen and colour-matched hardtop, the FP36 GTX delivers an unforgettable on-water profile. Hand built and highly customisable, her potency of form is mirrored by a reinforced deep-V hull for best-in-class seakeeping and powerful performance.

With her jet-black hull and topsides, contrasting with synthetic teak decks and custom steelwork, the new Limited Edition Focus Power 36 GTX is unquestionably a beautiful boat and the fit-out is also first-class. Both the lower deck spaces and the cockpit seating are lined with Italian leather and all the equipment are sourced from the world's most exclusive brands.

The versatile cockpit is keenly optimised for open-air recreation. In addition to a forward sunbed and secure walkaround side decks, she features a port wet-bar, a six-person dining station, a two-metre sun lounger aft and a large canvas open sunroof for socialising under the sun.

The GTX also features LED strip lighting along both edges of the side decks for a dash of extra flamboyance. And in addition to her twin Simrad displays, the new custom-built dashboard includes technology, enabling you to control your various on board systems.

The lower deck layout is particularly noteworthy, as it optimises space while providing a cozy atmosphere for relaxation and overnight stays. The configuration featuring two well appointed and spacious double cabins that can comfortably accommodate guests. Natural light is facilitated by the portholes, creating a warm, inviting atmosphere. The single bathroom serves both cabins and is designed to maximising space without compromising comfort. The interior layout is therefore ideal for weekends away, extended cruises or even commercial charter.

While the private double cabins are split by a spacious central lounge, the use of expansive glazing panels and highly bespoke finishes lends the entire living space a bright 'waterfront apartment' feel.

This layout makes the Focus Power 36 GTX an excellent choice for those looking to maximise the utility of their living space while ensuring privacy and comfort for all guests.
