Featuring a sophisticated dual-step hull design, the Venom 39 delivers exceptional offshore capabilities while optimizing speed and efficiency.

Equipped with Raymarine 16" GPS that incorporates digital switching, comprehensive mapping, and sonar capabilities, along with a FUSION Marine Audio system featuring four high-performance speakers, the Venom 39 elevates both navigation and onboard entertainment. The thoughtfully designed layout presents versatile seating arrangements (2+3) and a well-appointed wet bar, complete with a two refrigerators and a sink, all elegantly set against a backdrop of premium teak decking. The Ribco Venom 39 transcends mere boating; it offers a sophisticated experience, where safety, speed, and luxury converge within an exquisitely crafted vessel.

Notably, for the first time, a RIBCO model features a U-shaped bench, providing enhanced space and comfort for its owners. The Venom 39 also includes a bow cabin, a spacious head compartment, a solar panel for efficient battery charging. Furthermore, as with all Venom models, the Venom 39 showcases a T-Top crafted entirely from carbon fiber, a true masterpiece of engineering we take immense pride in. This innovative feature not only enhances rigidity compared to traditional stainless steel but also reduces the vessel's weight by over 100 kilograms, effectively lowering its center of gravity and optimizing performance.
